Tuition Payments Through FACTS = 9 or 10 monthly installments or Paid in Full, with annual FACTS processing fee

Tuition payments may be made in either 10 monthly installments (June 2026 through March 2027) or 9 monthly installments (June through March), excluding the registration month of January. All tuition and incidental payments must be made through FACTS via your Family Portal.

HNES does not accept government vouchers or public funding for tuition, including the HBI funding passed during the 2023 Florida legislative session. As an independent school, Holy Nativity chooses not to participate in State or Federal scholarship or voucher programs in order to avoid the oversight, mandates, reporting, audits, or other requirements that may accompany such funding. Serving students in Jr. Pre-K through 8th grade, we take pride in our identity as an Independent Episcopal School, retaining full autonomy over our curriculum, programs, experiences, and educational priorities—always guided by what we believe is best for our students. Financial Aid

Holy Nativity is committed to attracting well-rounded, diverse and motivated students. We believe enrollment should be accessible to all families; therefore, we offer need-based financial aid for students in grades K–8. The enrollment deposit is non-refundable. Applications are completely confidential and filed through the National Association of Independent Schools, School Student Services (SSS) at <https://sssandtadsfa.my.site.com/familyportal/FamilyLogin>. A \$60 application fee applies. The deadline for returning students' financial aid applications is March 1, 2026. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis; however, funding may be limited for applications submitted after the deadline.

BASE (Before/After School Enrichment)

Tuition covers the hours of instruction: Jr. Pre-K & Pre-K, 8:00 – 12:00; K & 1st grade, 8:00 – 2:45; 2nd grade through 8th grade, 8:00 – 3:00. There is an additional 15 minutes of supervision allotted for pick-up time. Students at school before or after these hours will attend the Before and After School Enrichment (BASE) program which is billed on an hourly basis. BASE is available between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. before school and after school until 5:30 p.m. The cost is \$9.50 per hour.

Lunch

Lunch is \$9.50, and milk/juice is \$1.50 (Prices are subject to change due to vendor increases). Lunch and BASE bills are charged monthly via FACTS and listed under “Family Billing” on your Parent Web account.

Additional Expenses

Field Trips

Classes at Holy Nativity often participate in school-sponsored field trips, which are planned to enhance their grade-level curriculum. These field trips can be an additional expense for the students. Parents and grandparents are always welcome to attend HNES field trips. Field trips and their associated costs are subject to change; all costs listed below are estimates only. There are also annual field trips for specific levels:

- *4th Grade to support Florida History, St. Augustine (approx. \$600 per person)
- *5th Grade to support American History, Boston (approx. \$1,850 per person)
- *6th Grade to support earth, space, and environmental science, NASA Space Camp Huntsville, AL (approx. \$700 per person)
- *7th Grade to support American History and Government, DC (approx.. \$1,700 per person including airfare)
- *8th Grade to support American History and Government, NYC (approx.. \$1,750 per person including airfare)
